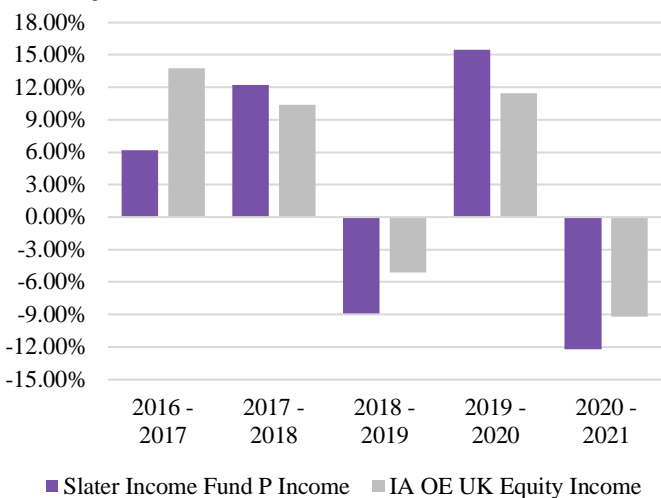


Discrete Year Performance
